28 Hudson Valley Artists Selected for 22nd Annual *Fall for Art* Fundraiser at The Chateau in Kingston on September 6th

Kingston, NY: ***Fall for Art***, an annual juried art show, sale and fundraising cocktail reception, hosted by the Jewish Federation of Ulster County, celebrates its 22nd event on Thursday, September 6th from 5:00-8:00pm at The Chateau, 240 Boulevard in Kingston, NY. Twenty-eight area artists representing a wide range of artistic media (including: painting, pottery, jewelry, fiber, glass, wood and mixed media) will be present to sell and talk about their work. The annual event supports area not-for-profit organizations including the Hudson Valley Food Bank, Family of Woodstock, Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA), People's Place, Angel Food East, Jewish Family Services, and area synagogues, among others. Each year a special recipient is selected, and for 2018, the Ulster County SPCA has been invited to select \$1,000 worth of artwork from the show to enhance their facility at 20 Wiedy Road in Kingston.
